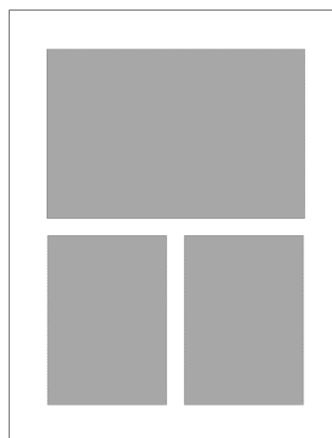
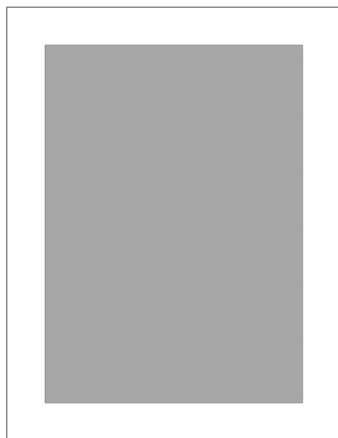

Advertising Guidelines for IGHR 2021 Virtual Institute

- Ads may be submitted in color, black and white, or grayscale.
- Camera-ready ads must be submitted electronically as a .tif (300 dpi) or .pdf file.
- All advertisements must meet IGHR/GGS criteria for quality of design and typesetting. IGHR/GGS reserves the right to refuse any advertisement and does not endorse any advertiser.
- Interior ad placement is subject to layout editor's design requirements.
- No advertisement space will be reserved until payment is received. Invoice provided on request.
- Ads and payment must be received no later than 30 June 2021.
